1. Balance

Equalize your drawing.



2. Color

Enhance, identify and enlighten your drawing. A little bit of color goes a long way



3. Grouping

Avoid "clutter," draw objects in "families."



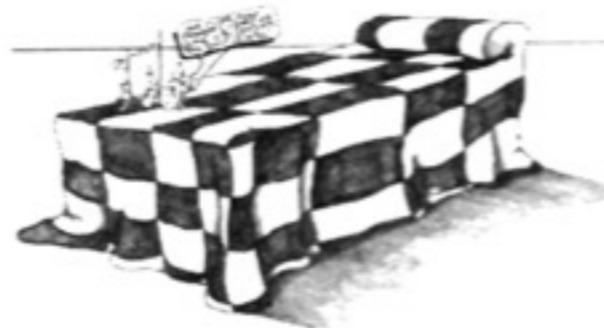
4. Natural Design

5. Plaid and Checkers

Draw patterns on blank surfaces for visual effect.



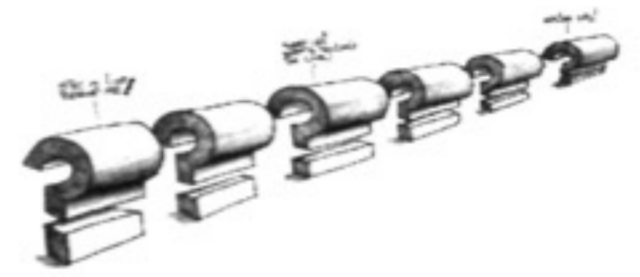
6. Proportion

Identify the size relationship of objects.



7. Repetition

Repeating patterns are pleasing to the eye.



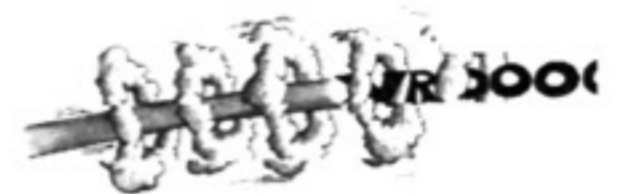
8. S Curve

Flowing lines add style to your picture.



9. Silhouette

Separate and identify distance of objects with bold dark shapes.



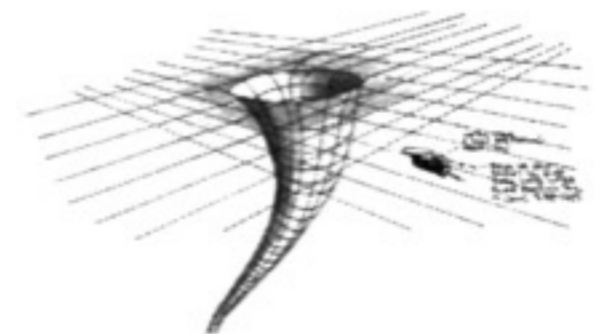
10. Skewed Curve

Curve some lines more at one end than the other.



11. Spiral

Patterns create rhythm in your picture.



12. Splash

Add action and movement lines away from one source.



13. Spots

Surface patterns identify objects while adding more character.



18. Texture

Patterns creating a visual feeling for the surface of an object.



14. Stripes

Vertical, horizontal, or diagonal lines repeating a pattern.



19. Tilt

Leaning an object to add character and effect.



15. Sunburst

Lines, colors, or patterns radiating from a central point.



20. Twist

Bending or knotting an object to add interesting character.



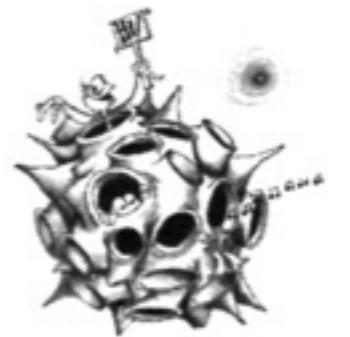
16. Symmetry

Similar shapes drawn on opposing sides of a picture for balance and effect.



21. Value

Adding different tones of color or shading for contrast.



17. Taper

Lines or objects that are wide at one side and narrow at the other.



22. Variety

Creative changes in repeated objects or patterns for a visually pleasing aesthetic effect.
